

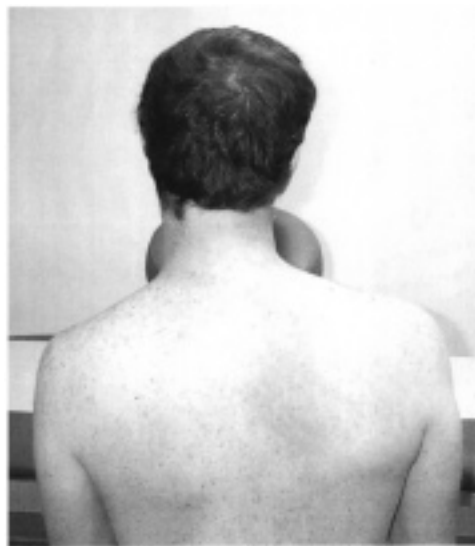
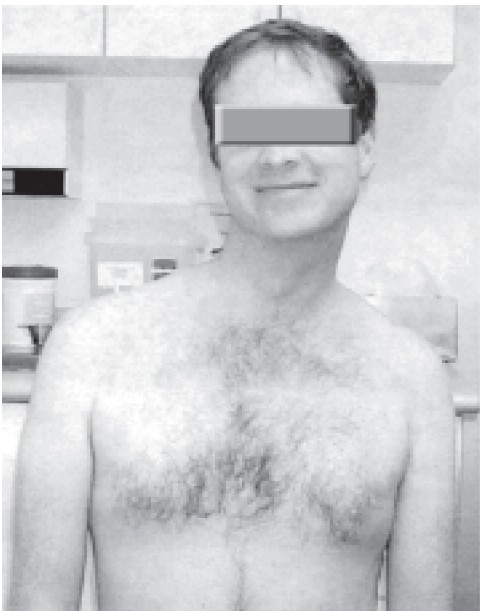
I-STOP 31 August 2001

Torticollis is a painful condition of the cervical spine associated with sustained rotary deformity of the neck. Upon admission, the patient's syndrome had proven resistant to conventional treatments such as physical therapy and Botox injections. Careful physical examination confirmed that there was underlying neuropathy.

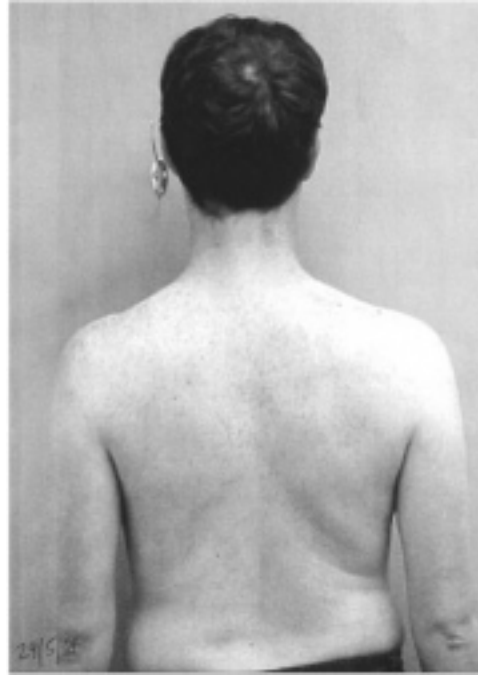
Admission - 25 / 10 / 2000
